

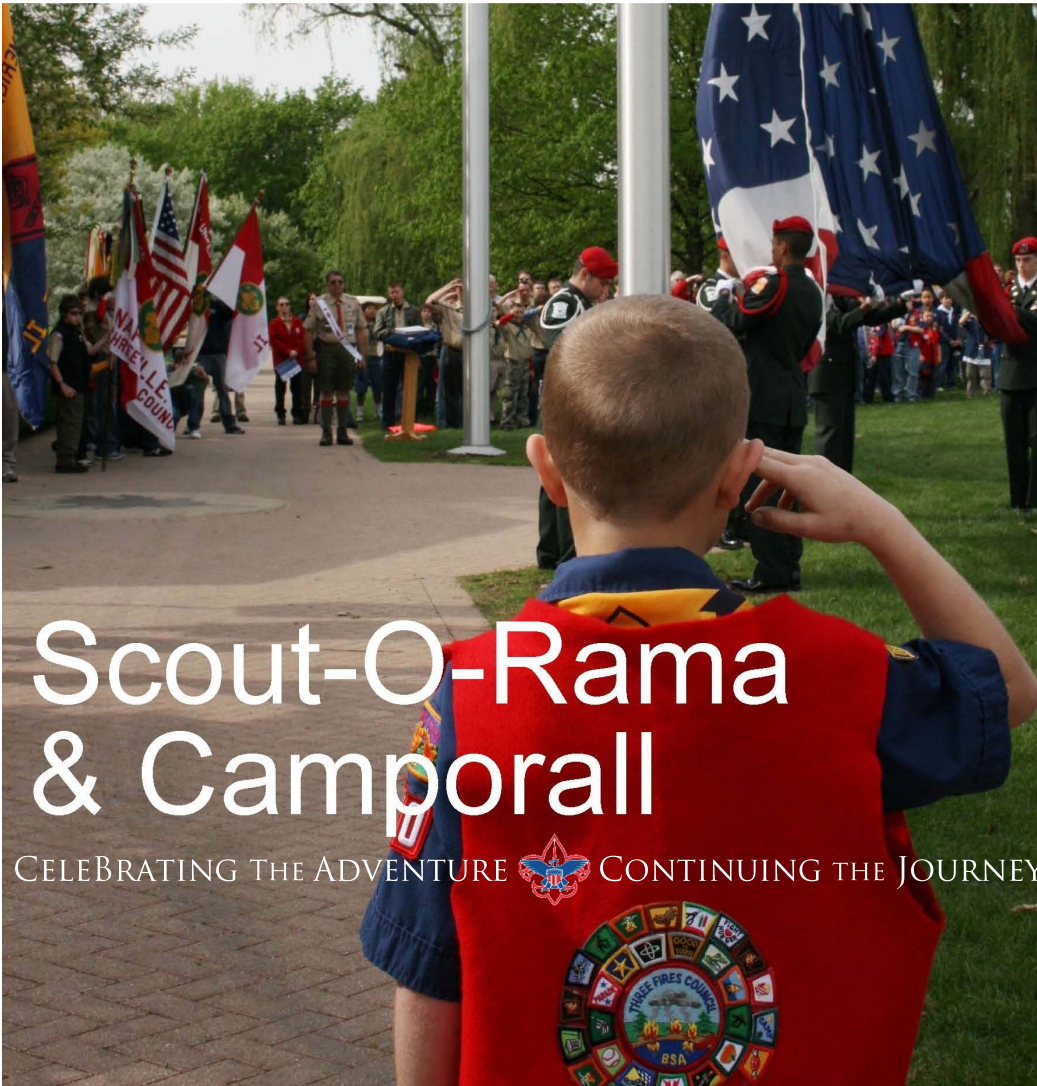

In 2010, through the generous support of Cantigny and its staff, the Three Fires Council will host a 100th Anniversary Scout-O-Rama, “Celebrating the Adventure ~ Continuing the Journey” at Cantigny Park in Winfield, the 500 acre public park and former estate of Colonel Robert R. McCormick.

Scout units, community partners, vendors, and others will showcase 100 years of Scouting’s adventures to an estimated 12,000 participants and guests to include an opening, afternoon, and closing ceremonies. The Three Fires Council will also camp 5,000 Scouts across the street at the Forest Preserve District of DuPage County, St. James Farm. A first-time partnership for both organizations, this will be a commemorative occasion for Scouts and St. James Farm.
